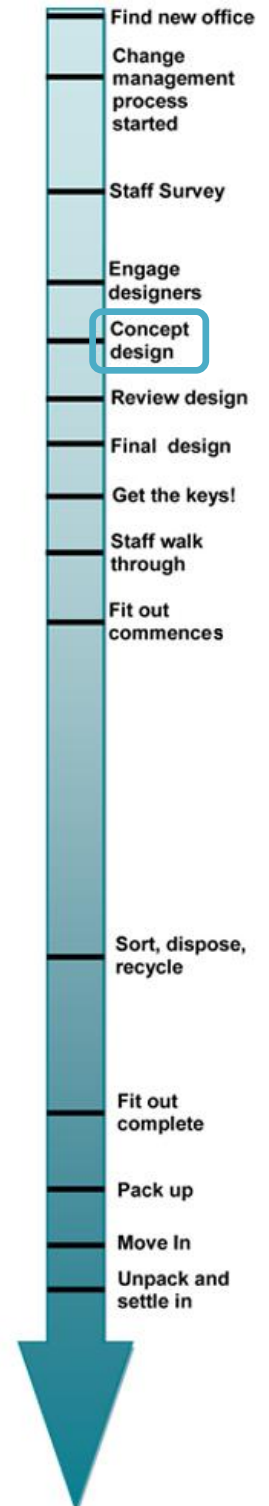

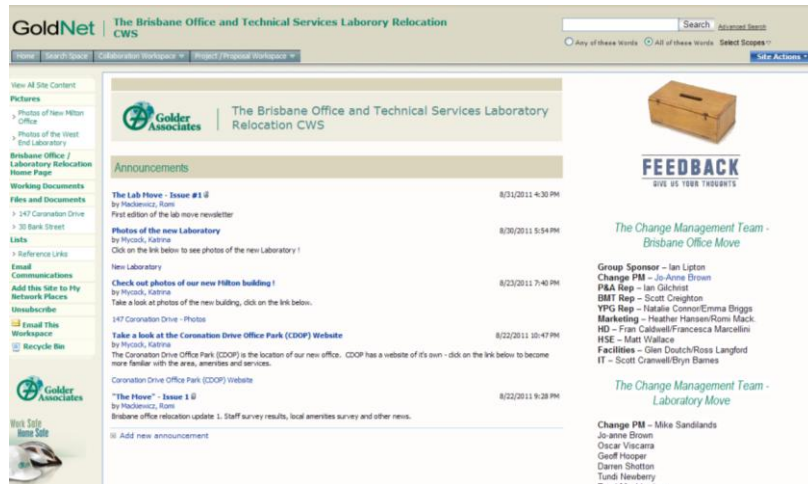

Fitout Kicks Off!

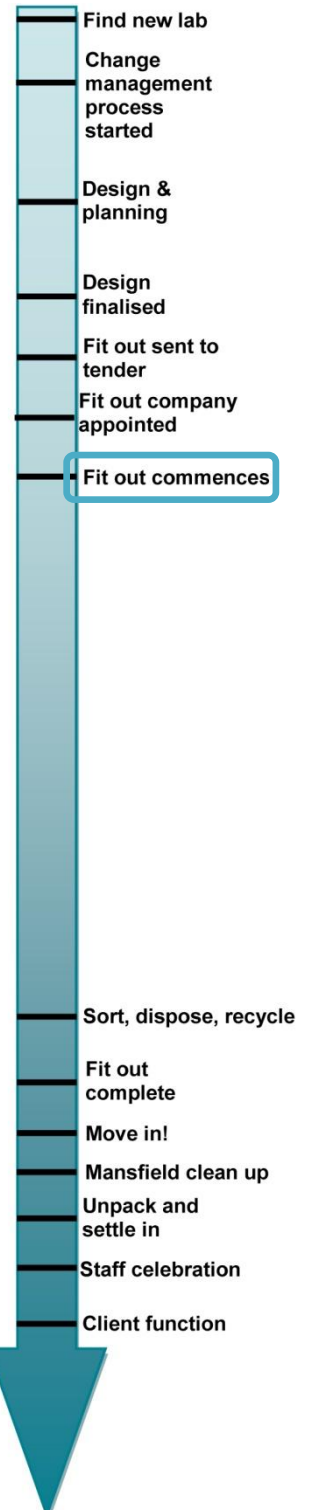
